Coding competitions are events where developers are encouraged to build original and functional prototype of an application. This activity happens in a competitive environment where best coders show case their coding skills.

Finding solutions to problems within a specified time period is not just challenging but it also helps improve problem-solving capabilities in coders who can then translate such gains to real-world situations. To encourage coders our Tech Developers Community planned to conduct an online coding contest in the name of 'CODEATHON'. They used a platform called Hackerrank for this contest.

The event consisted of two rounds, Debug Arena and Code Master. In the 1st round, codes with errors were shared which the participants had to debug and make it run successfully. In the 2nd round, problem statements were given for which the participants must develop the code from Scratch.

About 51 members participated in the contest and E-certificates has been provided for both the participants and the winner. It was felt quite knowledgeable and interesting by the participants.


#### **BROTHERHOOD CLUB**
