Passion is the key!







COVID-19 VACCINE

War against the virus

The world has never been in more of a frenzy in almost a century. The raging pandemic and the surrounding panic has us all looking forward to a miracle – A vaccine!

With dozen countries developing vaccine for corona virus, including Australia, Britain, U.S. and China, the scientists are positive it will be late 2020 or early next year for a COVID-19 Vaccine. The countries have also been investing in vaccine candidates while hoping for their own, one of the leading candidates being developed by Oxford produced University and by AstraZeneca.

While groups like GAVI are working to buy doses for poor countries,

AstraZeneca has consented to license its vaccine to India's Serum Institute for production of 1 billion doses. The World Health Organisation (WHO) has been formulating guidelines for justified distribution of vaccines and it is expected that the distribution will begin with greater risk areas and incline towards the rest.

Indian scientists agreed, due to the mutating nature of the virus, the availability of COVID-19 vaccine will be around the end of the year, echoing the scientists from around the world.


