



The event took place at the Anugraha Relief and Rehabilitation Service and Residential Centre for Spinal Cord Injured, located in Masagoundanchettipalayam, on 9 September 2022. There were about 50 patients in the facility, people from all walks of life, including paralympic champions, receiving treatment.




#### **TECHNOVA**





So through this program, those who had yet not linnked their Voter ID to their Aadhar card were aided.
